Forgiveness– The Truth

Matthew 18:21-33

I think that most of us are familiar fairly familiar with this story. The question was posed: “How many times shall I forgive my brother when he sins against me? Up to seven times?” The Lord responds, “I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times.”

So often, forgiveness is taken for granted, or in some cases – not granted – at all. Think about this gift. We are forgiven of all of our sins. This was not an easy sacrifice for God to make. His Son, Jesus, hung on a cross and died in order for us to be freed of our sins.

Yet it is so often that I see how people wrong others and for some reason we feel that justifies us to wrong them back. We wronged Jesus and God with our sin. Did God look at us and think about how He would get His payback – NO! In fact it was just the opposite. He gave His only Son to die for us on the cross. Why is it then, that we find it so hard to forgive someone else? Another question could be asked: Why is it so hard for us to ask another for forgiveness when we know we have wronged them?

We talked about forgiveness this week in chapel. The message that I left the students with is this... Look at the word forgiveness – forgiveness is “for giving” to one another. God knew we are part of a sinful world and that we weren't perfect. He forgave us for our sins. We should model and practice this idea of forgiveness being “for giving” to others.
